Platinum Estates invests 70 million to build a hotel in Malaga

The assets will be located in the municipality of Casares and will be managed by Hilton through its Conrad brand. The complex is expected to open in early 2022.

Platinum Estates invests 70 million to build a hotel in Malaga. Platinum Estates is growing in Malaga. The company will invest seventy million euros in the construction of a hotel on the Costa del Sol, in the municipality of Casares, which will open in 2022.



The hotel, owned by Markway Inversiones, will have 194 rooms and will be managed by Hilton under the Conrad brand. The resort will have a spa and indoor pool, bars, and a fine-dining restaurant, according to Cinco Días.

It will be the first hotel to manage the luxury brand in Europe, which plans to expand across the continent. Before the coronavirus crisis, the hotel sector had previously added 26,000 rooms in 2020.
